- ELIGIBILITY -

1. For the purpose of The ROI Art Prize, the entry is defined as an original artwork, dimensions no smaller than 1200mm on its shortest side and capable of being displayed on an easel if shortlisted for the foyer exhibition (see below).
2. The prize is open to all artists living in, working in, or represented by galleries, in the municipalities of **Yarra, Darebin and Moreland**.
3. The ROI Art Prize is an **acquisitive prize**. Each year's winner will be awarded **\$10,000**. The artwork remains the property of the ROI. The annual prize is sponsored by the owners of the ROI, and corporate sponsors Nelson Alexander Real Estate and Win Energy.
4. **A People's Choice selection** is also conducted by residents' votes. The selected artwork will receive a **prize of \$1000** on the presentation night and will leave the artwork to hang at the ROI for 12 months, after which it will be auctioned at the following year's presentation night. The reserve shall not exceed the price submitted on entry. The ROI reserves the right to bid for the work, or buy it if not sold. If not sold, it will be returned to the artist.
5. All entries must be the **original work** of the submitting artist and must have been designed or completed within two years prior to November 2017.
6. There is no limit to the number of entries an artist can submit. A separate application form must accompany each entry. (Application forms are available on the ROI website – roiapartments.com.au) Only one work per artist will be shown in the exhibition.
7. **Entries close at 5pm on Wednesday 8 November 2017**. A photo of the artwork, along with the entry form must be submitted to the ROI Art Prize email address by that date. No late entries will be accepted.
8. Entries must be suitable for display on easels and the winners will be responsible for framing their works suitable for hanging once winners are announced.

- SELECTION PROCESS -

1. There will be two rounds of judging. The first round by the pre-selection judges, who will choose 10 paintings for the exhibition. Shortlisted artists will be notified and must deliver their works no later than Friday 17 November 2017.
2. Three independent, qualified judges will decide the winners of the 2017 ROI Art Prize from the works selected for exhibition, which will be mounted on easels in the foyer of the ROI Apartments at 4 Bik Lane, North Fitzroy from Monday 20 November to Friday 24 November.
3. During the exhibition, residents of The ROI will be invited to vote for the People's Choice Award. In the event the People's Choice is the same as the winner, the artwork with the second highest number of votes will be announced as the People's Choice.
4. The winners will be announced at a cocktail party function in the foyer of the ROI at 6pm on Thursday 24 November 2017. **It is a condition of entry that winners or their representatives must be present to collect their awards.**

- EXHIBITION CRITERIA & PROCESS -

1. Works selected for the exhibition must be delivered on Friday 17 November or Saturday 18 November. All works must be available for the full exhibition period of Monday 20 November until Friday 25 November.
2. Artists selected for exhibition are responsible for the transport of their work to and from the ROI. This includes freight and transport costs in both directions.
3. Artists selected for exhibition must have provided two print quality images of their final work and an artist statement with their entry form.
4. All works exhibited in the ROI Art Prize exhibition, **except the \$10,000 winner, will be for sale.** The People's Choice winner will be sold by auction at the 2018 presentation event. **The sale price listed on the entry form will remain as the final sale price on all promotional material if the artist is selected as a finalist.**
5. All care will be taken when handling works and a security guard will be in attendance during the exhibition period. The ROI however will not be responsible for loss, theft or damage. Artists are responsible for the shipping and insurance cover of their artworks.
6. The placement of all winner's works within the ROI will be at the discretion of the 2017 Art Prize Committee.
7. Artists grant the ROI Art Prize Committee and its licensees the right to reproduce their work and biographical material by any means in any media for archival and promotional purposes. The artist and their gallery (if applicable) will be properly acknowledged in such material.
8. Works that are not collected by Wednesday 30 November 2017 will become the property of the ROI, unless arrangements have been negotiated and agreed in writing, without any liability to the ROI. After this date, the ROI may use or dispose of the work as it determines.
